What is Invisalign®?

Whether young or old, start smiling more. Invisalign® is the invisible way to straighten teeth using a series of custom-made, virtually undetectable aligners. This type of tooth straightening has proven to be effective in practices across the world and is backed by considerable clinical research. So if you have teeth that are crowded, too far apart or that have moved since wearing braces – you'll have a new reason to smile. Proven results behind great smiles.

Our dentists have already been trained to treat their patients with Invisalign® and they can determine if Invisalign® is right for you. We have treated many patients successfully, including one of our own dentists.

How does Invisalign® work?

After your free consultation, your dentist will decide if this course of treatment is right for you. If the decision is made to use Invisalign®, they will write a treatment plan and take impressions and x-rays of your teeth, which will then be submitted to Invisalign®. Then, using the latest advances in 3D computer technology, your dentist's instructions will be translated into a 3D film showing your teeth moving into their new straighter position. If you are happy with this presentation, then a series of precisely customised aligners will be made. You will then wear each set of aligners for about two weeks. Each aligner is slightly different, moving your teeth gradually week by week, until you've achieved the intended result - straighter teeth.

For this treatment you generally do not have to visit your dentist any more than you would with conventional metal braces, around every six weeks. The length of treatment varies from as little as several months to over a year in complex cases.

No braces. Nothing to hold you back.

Invisalign® needs no metal wires or brackets, which makes it extremely comfortable. And because it's removable, eating, brushing and flossing are no problem. You can still enjoy your favourite foods and smile without having to hold back.

Does Invisalign® hurt?

No. Some teeth that are being moved in a particular aligner will be tender for a day or two, but otherwise Invisalign® is incredibly comfortable compared to standard braces.

How much does Invisalign® cost?

As with traditional braces, the cost is usually based around the complexity of your case and the length of treatment. The initial consultation is free. If you then decide to proceed onto the 3D film called the "Clincheck", then a fee of £500 will be charged to cover the initial costs incurred from Invisalign®. If you then proceed to treatment, this fee is deducted from the final total. Average prices for Invisalign® are £3,000-£4,000.
